

Definition

Bullying is the repeated physical and psychological harassment suffered by a student from another one or from other schoolmates.



Forms of bullying

Negative actions can be carried out through physical contact, orally, teasing and insulting gestures which involve the deliberate exclusion.



Identifying the bully

The bullying behaviour is defined as the negative behaviour from several people against somebody who finds it difficult to defend themselves.



Identifying bullying

Bullying must take place in a repeated way over a period of time, with the purpose of hurting or annihilating the victim and there is an imbalance of power between the victim and the bully.




Identifying the victim




- They are addressed by nicknames.
- They suffer aggressions without defending themselves.
- Irregular attendance at school.
- They show fear when they finish school.

Identifying the victim II

- They make an illogical detour to go or come from school.
- Sometimes they become unusually aggressive.
- They look sad and they don't want to talk about it.
- They swing moods suddenly.

Physical Bullying

It's the commonest type. There are hits, shoves and even beatings among one or several aggressors against just one victim. Apart from that, the deliberate stealing or damaging of their belongings.



Psychological bullying



- There exists a persecution, bullying, tyranny, blackmailing, manipulation and threats against the other. They hurt the victim's self-esteem and foster their feeling of fear.

Verbal bullying

It is meant to discriminate, spread rumours, carry out exclusion actions or insulting and repeated jokes.



Sexual bullying



Sexual abuse or malicious references to intimate areas in the victim's body. This type includes the homophobic bullying when the abuse makes reference to the victim's sexual orientation .

Cyberbullying I

- Very serious bullying because of the great visibility and reach of the humiliation against the victim and the bullies' anonymity, with text messages in mobile phones, web pages and blogs, e-mails, chats, sick online polls, social networks, identity theft to send messages, etc.



Cyberbullying II




- Insults, photo or sick video manipulation, victim's inappropriate images taken without their permission, mocks concerning origin, religion, victim or relatives and friends' socioeconomic level, etc. Anything goes to humiliate them.

Social bullying

- Isolate the young in the group, ignoring them. It can be direct: excluding, without letting the victim participate in activities, take them out of the group. Or it can be indirect: by ignoring, treating them like an object, as if they didn't exist.
