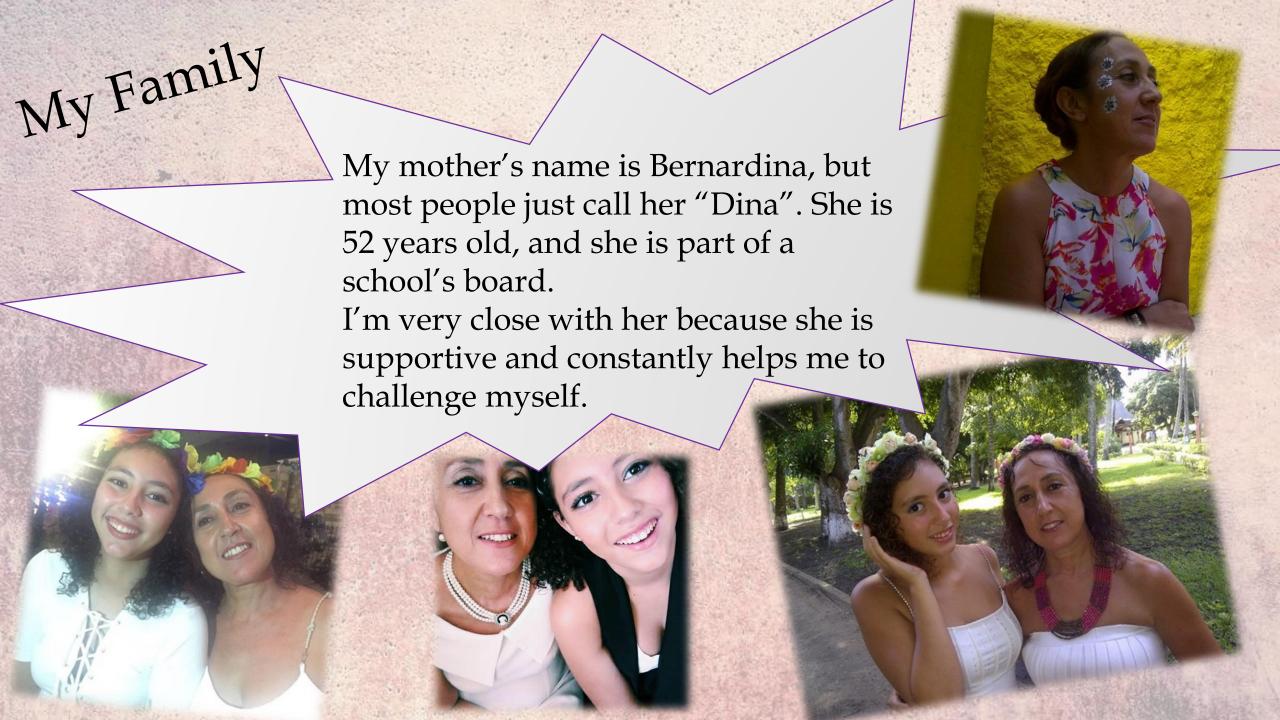

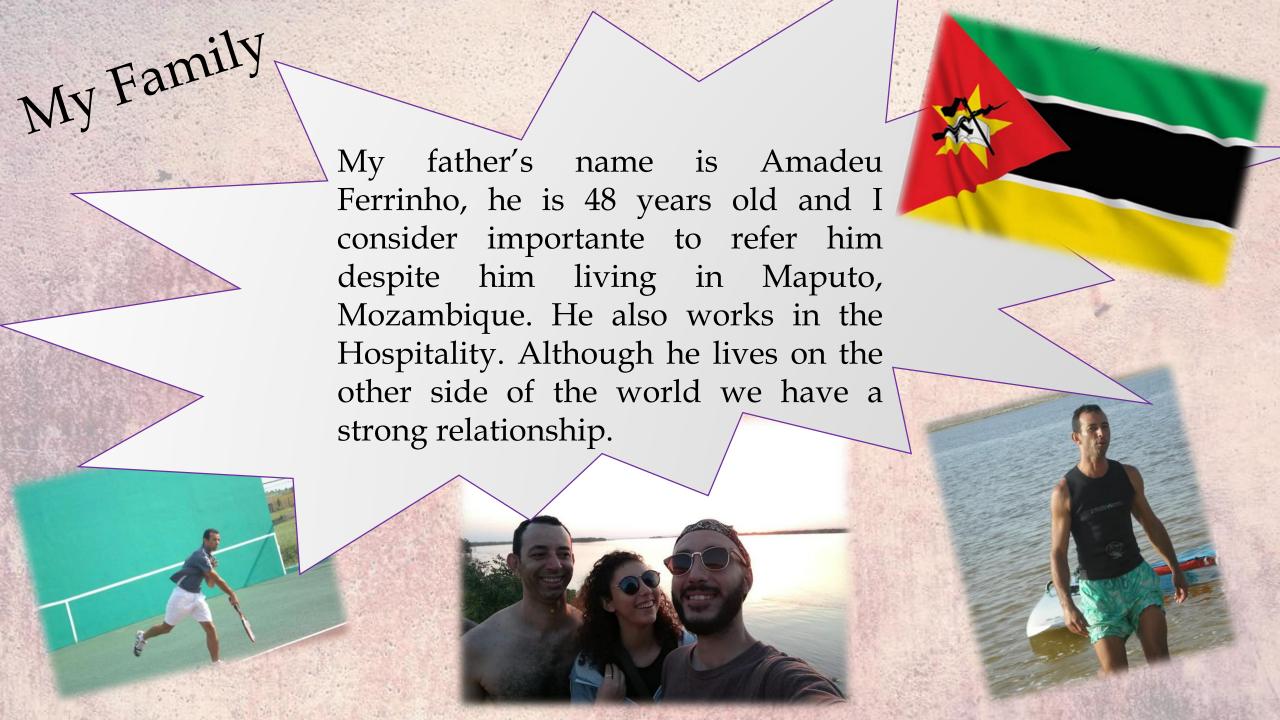

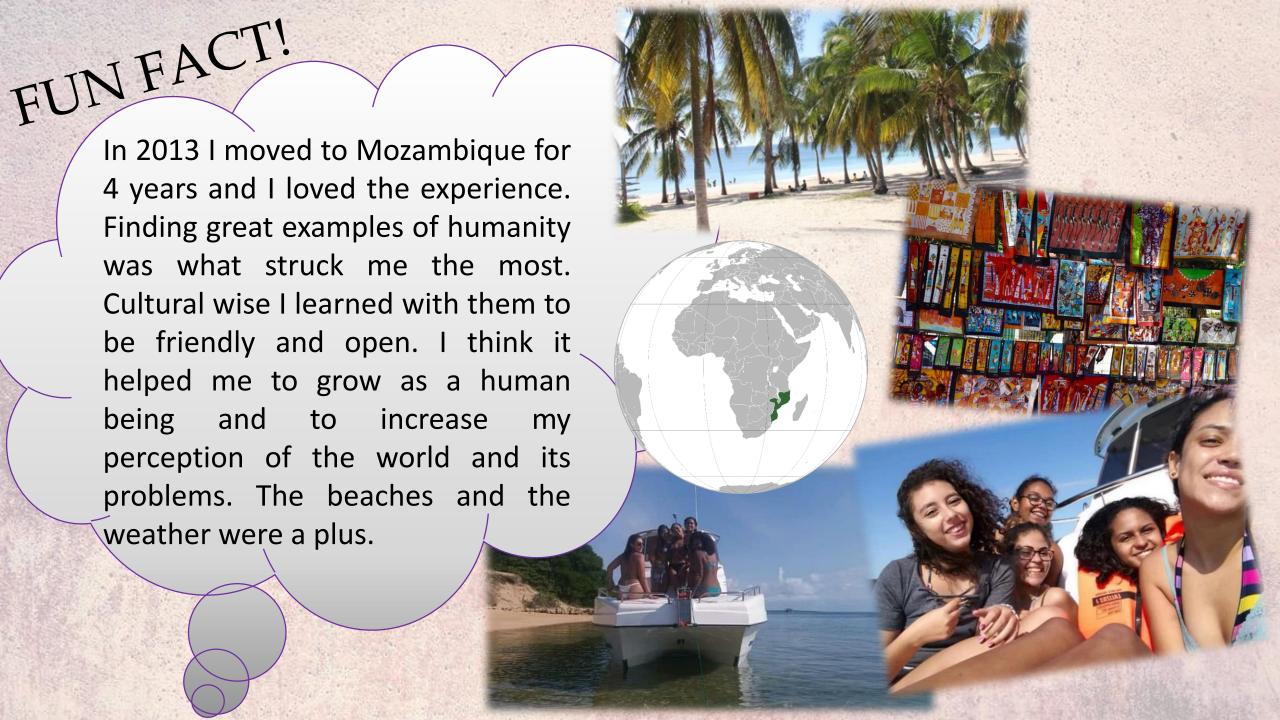
















My daily Routine

*6:30 PM - Friday (Theatre Group)

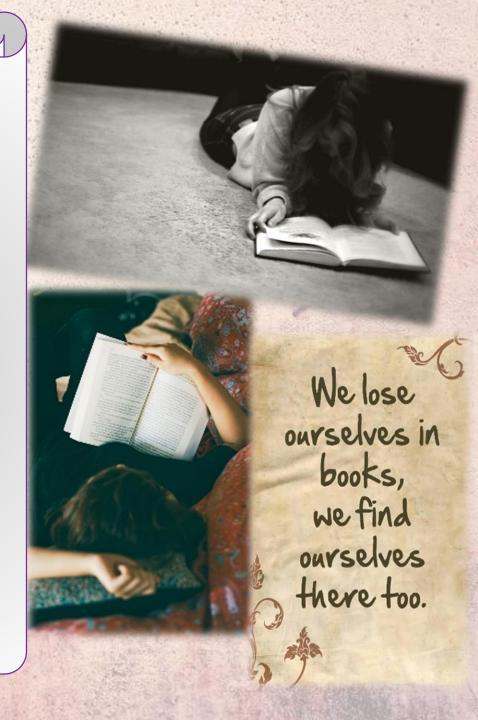

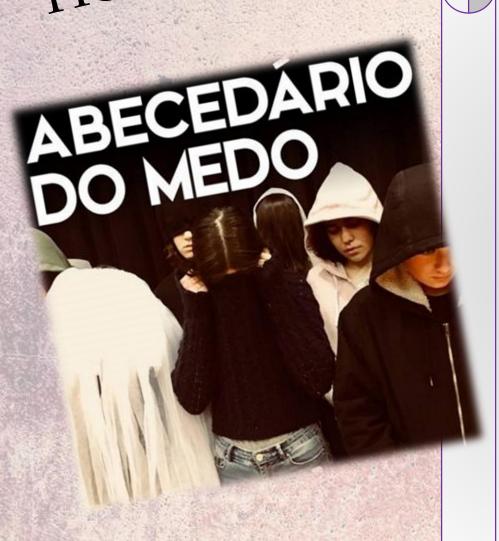


Writing has been an important part of my life since 5th or 6th grade. I consider it my refuge.

Reading is also extremely important part of my life. I don't have a favourite type of book, since I love all kinds of books from fiction, to novels, to nonfiction, etc.



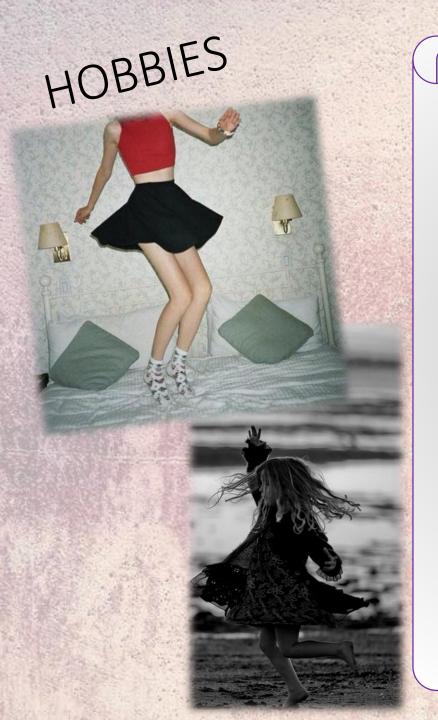

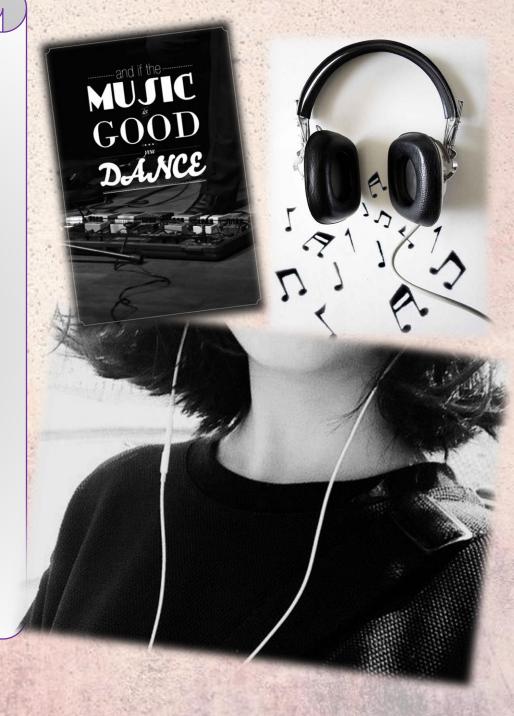
